RETURN TO CAMPUS FOR THE UPCOMING TRIMESTER

INTRODUCTION

As we are preparing to start a new academic year of 2022/2023, this announcement serves as early information for all undergraduate and postgraduate students in terms of academic operation, on-campus accommodation, and safety and health.



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ACADEMIC OPERATION

(a) UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

1. Starting from Trimester 1, 2022/2023 of Academic Calendar 1.0 and 2.0 onwards, the University has decided on the teaching and learning activities. They are as follows:
 - All students except Distance Education (DE) and students with special permission from the faculties, are required to be physically present on campus.
 - All mass lectures will be conducted in the mode to be determined by the respective faculties. Kindly refer to the faculty for the mode of delivery.
 - All tutorials, labs, and studios will be conducted in face-to-face mode.
 - Examination will be conducted physically on campus.
2. Students who are affected by COVID-19 or being close contact with COVID-19 patients are required to notify their respective lecturers for further arrangements of the teaching and learning activities. Special hybrid classes will be arranged for students in this situation.
3. The University will keep you posted on any necessary changes or developments following directives from the Ministry of Higher Education (MoHE) and the Ministry of Health (MoH).

(b) POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

4. All postgraduate students including international students should return to campus according to their trimester or as required by their supervisors.
5. Below is the information related to the academic operations and trimester commencement date for Research, Online Distance Learning and Coursework programmes.
 - **Research Programmes:**
Research meeting mode will be communicated by the respective supervisor and co-supervisor.
 - **Online Distance Learning Programmes - Executive Master of Business Administration (EMBA) & Master of Computer Science in Software Engineering (MCS SE):**
All classes will be conducted via online mode.



- **Coursework Programmes**

For the Existing Students of Master of Electrical and Electronic Engineering (MEEE) and Master of Engineering in Telecommunications (MEng Tele) programmes, Faculty of Engineering (FOE)

- > Starting from Trimester 2 (14 Nov 2022) onwards
- Students are required to be present on campus.

For the June 2022 intake students of Master of Electrical and Electronic Engineering (MEEE) and Master of Engineering in Telecommunications (MEng Tele) programmes, Faculty of Engineering (FOE)

- > Starting from Trimester 1 (26 Sept 2022) onwards
- Students are required to be present on campus.

For students of the following programmes:

- Master of Science in Engineering Business Management (MSc EBM), FOE
- Master of Business Administration (MBA) & Doctor of Business Administration, Faculty of Management (FOM)
- Master of Creative Multimedia (MCM), Faculty of Creative Multimedia (FCM)

- > Starting from Trimester 2 (17 Oct 2022) onwards:
Students are required to be present on campus

■ ON-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

6. Students who would like to stay in the campus hostel, you must apply and obtain approval from the hostel management before returning to campus.

SAFETY AND HEALTH

8. Even though the government has announced the relaxation of several SOPs as we are in the endemic phase, all MMU staff and students share the responsibility to remain vigilant and continue to keep our communities safe as well as minimise the impact of COVID-19.

11. Meanwhile, students who have tested positive for COVID-19 should report their condition to STyLE department and their respective faculties. The students also need to be quarantined and update on the status in the MySejahtera apps.

13. Please take note that international students who have obtained an e-VAL in 2022 must enter Malaysia within 6 months period as stipulated in the visa document. Physical presence in Malaysia is required to complete the entire visa process.
