ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Malaysian Students

- Pass SPM / 0 Level or its equivalent with minimum of grade C in at least three (3) subjects, inclusive of Mathematics and a Pass in English; OR
- Pass UEC with minimum of grade B in at least three (3) subjects inclusive of Mathematics, and a Pass in English; OR
- Pass certificate in a related field from a recognised institution with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 out of 4.00 and a credit in Mathematics at SPM level or its equivalent

Note: Candidates without a credit in Mathematics at SPM level or its equivalent may be admitted if the Certificate programme contains subjects in Mathematics that are equivalent to Mathematics at SPM level.

English Entry Requirement for International Students:

All undergraduate programs offered by Faculty of Management and Faculty of Business require a minimum score of 5.5 in IELTS or its equivalent, except for Bachelor of Finance (Hons) and Bachelor of Financial Engineering (Hons), which require higher minimum score of 6.0 in IELTS or its equivalent.

Other programs require a minimum score of 5.0 in IELTS or its equivalent.
