

PERBADANAN TABUNG PENDIDIKAN TINGGI NASIONAL (PTPTN) LOAN

REQUIREMENT

- 1. Citizen of Malaysia (Does not exceed 45 years of age on the date of application)
- 2. Get an offer to study in MMU (Foundation, Diploma and Bachelor's Degree)
- 3. Has opened SSPN i / SSPN i Plus account.

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Application is to be made online at : http://www.ptptn.gov.my
- 2. Online application is open one (1) month prior to the closing dates. Annually there are 6 closing dates set by PTPTN for MMU

- Note: Application can be made after students completed their registration in MMU.
- 3. Open an SSPN i / SSPN i Plus account with a minimum savings of RM20.00. SSPN account can be opened at PTPTN branches or any SSPN agents, such as Maybank or through PTPTN Website
- 4. Buy a PIN number for RM5.00 which is available at online PTPTN website or all branches of the Bank Simpanan Nasional. The PIN number is valid for only 6 months after the date of application registration.
- 5. Open Personal CIMB conventional account. Disbursement of PTPTN loan will be debited into this account.

ONLINE APPROVAL

- 1. Approval of the application can be checked six (6) working days AFTER the closing date.
- 2. Online approval is on a conditional basis. PTPTN has the right to revoke the loan approval in the event of non compliance, incomplete documents, messy, dirty and too many mistakes and inadequate witness.
- 3. Completed agreement to be submitted to PTPTN within 14 days from the date of the letter of offer. The agreement which has been exceeding the validity period will be cancelled. Borrower is required to make a new application if still interested to loan PTPTN. MMU will arrange for the agreements collection at Campus. Announcement will be made through MMU online Bulletin Board.

IMPORTANT NOTES

PTPTN loan does not cover the entire semester fees. The students need to top up the balance not covered by the loan.

- Please note that PTPTN will not disburse the loan amount approved in one payment.
- The amount approved by PTPTN is based on parents' monthly income.
- The loan payment is credited directly to the student's CIMB account.
- The first loan payment is released only after the completed agreement is received by PTPTN.
- Subsequent payments will be made after PTPTN receives confirmation from MMU that the student is successful in continuing studies and has obtained a GPA of 2.0 and above

MMU FOUNDATION PROGRAMME IS ELIGIBLE FOR PTPTN LOAN

The approved amount is disbursed 3 (three) times a year. Amount of loan given are as shown below:

- WPP application is open at PTPTN website start from 1st 15th (1st batch PTPTN loan application)

Terms for application:

- Malaysian citizen
- Apply WPP after submit PTPTN loan application at PTPTN website (www.ptptn.gov.my)
- Must register at MMU for full time Diploma Programme
- Parent / Student must be a recipient of Bantuan Sara Hidup Rakyat (BSHR), and
- No debt with PTPTN
