Frequently Asked Questions: Week of Immersion and Networking (WIN) Programme

Q1: What is the purpose of the WIN programme, and why is it important?

- You will feel more comfortable about attending MMU after acquainting yourself on important information, for e.g. academics, finances, campus resources, etc., from the online orientation modules.
- You will also be able to meet other new students, student leaders, lecturers, and staff who might provide you with answers to critical questions, enable you to establish connections with others, and prepare you for your time at MMU.

Q2: When is the WIN Programme?

- New students enrolled for degree programmes: 3 April (starting at 3 pm) until 8 April (ending at 1 pm).
- New students enrolled for **foundation and diploma programmes: 24 April** (starting at 3 pm) until 29 April (ending at 1 pm)

Q3: Do we get our hostel room keys during the WIN Programme? When can we move in?

- You will be able to collect you hostel room keys on 3 April (degree programmes) and 24 April (foundation and diploma programmes) from the registration counters at Dewan Tun Canselor (Cyberjaya) and Main Hall (Melaka).
- You can check in right after receiving the hostel keys.

Q4: Where will the WIN Programme be held? Is it online or on campus?

- The WIN will be held on MMU campuses.
- You can join the WIN programme physically on campus or you can join via online.
- If you choose to study online this trimester, you should join the WIN programme via online. However, if you stay within the vicinity of MMU campuses, you can request to join the WIN programme physically on campus. Please request via email at stad@mmu.edu.my

Q5: How do I access the online WIN Programme modules?

- You will receive the Info Pack after registration.
- You will have access to the WIN Programme modules via the <u>WIN Portal</u>.

Q6: What can I do if I have not received a WIN Programme invitation or the Info Pack?

- You will have to complete your registration in order to receive the Info Pack.
- This can be done online (e-registration) or at the registration counters on campus on 3 April 2021 (degree programmes) or 24 April 2021 (foundation and diploma programmes).

- However, all lectures and tutorial sessions for the Faculty of Cinematic Arts students are conducted online only.
